

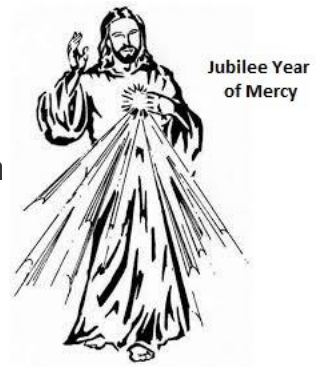

**ST. JOSEPH'S CHURCH'S INTEREST FREE LOAN: The Parish borrowed £120,000 for the Church Refurbishment (including new flooring, new heating system, 2new boilers, new drainage, lighting and painting of the whole Church) from various Parishes who gave us an interest-free loan.**

**We have been paying £10,000 /year towards this loan.**

**Interest-free loan runs out in NOVEMBER 2018 and to COMPLETE PAYING OFF THE LOAN OUR PARISH NEEDS ANOTHER £30,000.**

**INCOME FROM CHRISTMAS BAZAAR AND SUMMER FAIR GOES TO SERVICE THE DEBT. ALL OUR GENEROUS BENEFACTORS FROM OUR PARISH AND OTHER PARISHES ARE REMEMBERED IN OUR PRAYERS. SEA SUNDAY COLLECTION – next Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> JULY. The Apostleship of the Sea is a Catholic Charity supporting seafarers worldwide. They provide practical and pastoral care to all seafarers, regardless of nationality, race or belief. Port Chaplains and volunteer ship visitor's welcome seafarers, offer welfare services and advice, care and friendship.

The AoS in GB is part of international network known as Stella Maris. 90% of the world trade is transported by ship. However, the life of a modern seafarer can be dangerous and lonely. They may spend up to a year at a time away from home separated from their family and loved ones and working in harsh conditions. The AoS relies wholly on voluntary contributions and can only continue its work through the generous donations of its supporters, particularly in this collection. Thank you and God
